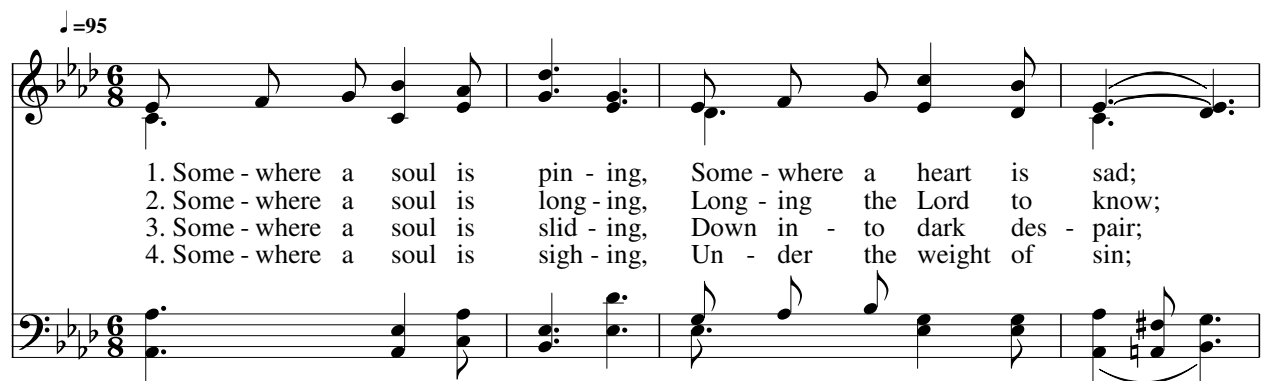

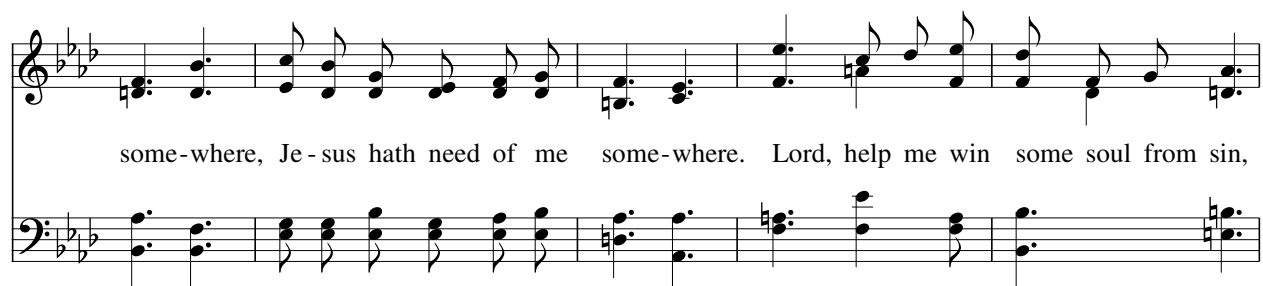


1. Some - where a soul is pin - ing, Some - where a heart is sad;
