


Touch the Hem of His Garment




1. Let me touch the hem of His gar - ment, And the touch will make me whole;

4. Let me touch the hem of His gar - ment, While the Bless - ed One is nigh;




Let me reach the bless - èd Sav - ior, The Re - deem - er of my soul.
